medicines, including those claimed to be used for weight reduction or treatment of

skin conditions. Some cases of which are currently being investigated.

Weight control should be achieved through adopting a healthy lifestyle,

including a balanced diet and appropriate exercise. People should consult health

care professionals before using any medicines for weight control.
